Fabric Supply list

2 yds of border fabric

1 2/3 yards of polka dot for Block B and for the setting triangles (see photo on page #1 for where it is used)

1 1/2 yards of multiple prints for the Block A, Middle border Fabric & Binding (the orange in the photo on page #1)

1 1/2 yard of prints - for sides of the Block A and some squares of Block B (You can use all the same, scrappy, or just 2 fabrics)

1/2 yard of stripe for the Block A corners

1/2 yard of Block B print for the squares

The original quilt has 2 orange fabrics and 2 gray fabrics, plus the stripe.

For my March Block a Day version I'll be more scrappy but keep the color Family the same.

An example is

- -using navy where the gray is
- -Using a navy stripe for the orange stripe
- -using yellow prints where the green is in the original guilt

Cutting Directions

Block A side Prints

- 80 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"

Block A & B Stripe

- 114 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Center Prints (also used for binding)

- 20 squares 4.5" x 4.5"
- 6 strips 1.5" x width of fabric for thin middle borders

Block B Prints

- 14 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Middle Border


- 2 strips 1.5" x 61"
- 2 strips 1.5" x 51 3/4"

Border fabric - Cut AFTER you measure your quilt center to **Customize** it


- 2 strips 6.5" x 63" outer border
- 2 strips 6.5" x 63 3/4" outer border
- 2 strips 2.5" x 57" inner border 2 strips 2.5" x 49 3/4" inner border

Polka Dot

- 12 rectangles 4.5" x 8.5"
- 24 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"
- 4 squares 13" x 13" side settings Cut in quarters on the Diagonal There will be 2 extra



- 2 Squares 7" x 7" Cut in half on the Diagonal for the 4 corners



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
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Block A directions

1) Following the diagram using the 4.5" center square, 4 strips 2.5" x 4.5", and 4 stripe 2.5" x 2.5" squares Measures 8.5" x 8.5"

Make 20 blocks



2.5" 2.5" x 4.5" x 2.5" 4.5" x 4.5"

> Unfinished Block to 8.5" x 8.5" Finished in the quilt is Size 8" x 8"

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
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
Block B directions

1) Following the diagram using a polka dot 4.5° x 8.5° , 2 polka dot 2.5° x 4.5° and The 2.5° squares vary by the block layout. See below Measures 8.5° x 8.5°


Make the # of blocks listed under each variation for a total of 12 blocks





Center Assembly

1) Following the diagram, layout all the block A and block B, all the Polka dot quarter square triangles, and all the polka dot half square triangles Sew in rows ON the diagonal.

TRIM to 45 3/4" x 57" BUT if you need it a bit larger to make it work that is fine. The borders you can make a little longer to work with the center you create.





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
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
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
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Border Assembly

- 1) Following the diagram Sew the borders as follows
- 2.5" borders to sides, then top & bottom
- 1.5" borders to sides, then top & bottom
- 6.5" borders to sides, then top & bottom









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
