For me all festivals are more magical with a Ferris Wheel! It is my Favorite. I am not sure why but they are just so cool during the day and even better with the lights at night.

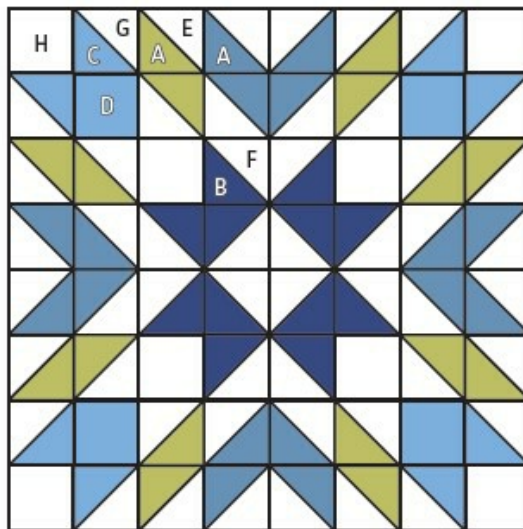

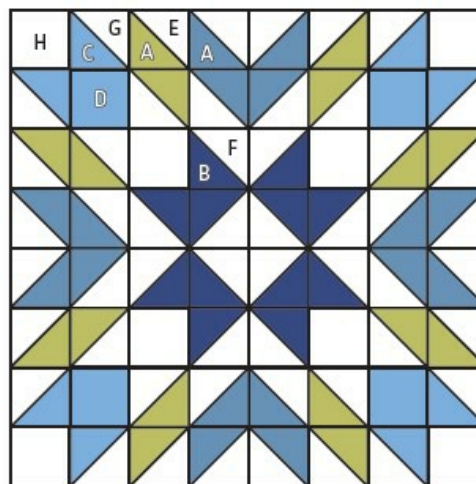
Block 1– Carnival Rides

Using the Fat Quarter Shop Triangles On a Roll FREE Pattern
Hosted by Pat Sloan At lovetomakequilts.com

HST Cutting Directions - NO triangle papers used
SEE Fat Quarter Shop pattern for rest of the pattern

Fabric A (blue): cut 8 – 5” squares
Fabric A (green): cut 8 – 5” squares
Fabric B: cut 6 – 5” squares
Fabric C: cut 4 – 5” squares
Fabric D: cut 4 – 4.5” squares
Fabric E/F/G Background placement:
cut 26 – 5” square
Fabric H Background: cut 8 - 4.5” squares

**** MAKE 1 block ****



Block is 32.5” x 32.5”
Finished size 32” x 32”

Use the Pattern <https://shrsi.com/412fl> and the 2 at a time HST method on the last page of this worksheet

Accuquilt Dies

–The 4” finished HST Die
#55031 or #55710

–The 4” finished square Die
#55708 or #50015

Fabric A&E (blue): Make 16 HST
Fabric A&E (green): Make 16 HST
Fabric B&F: Make 12 HST
Fabric C&G: Make 8 HST
Fabric D: cut 4 – 4.5” squares
Fabric H Background: cut 8 - 4.5” squares

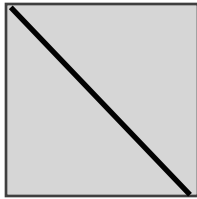

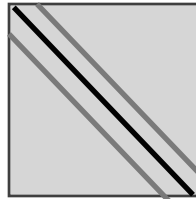
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

**NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book
"Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"**



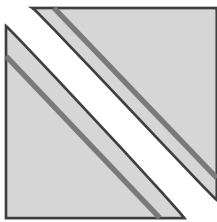
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

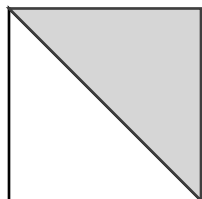
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 4.5" x 4.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
