

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

Cut 2 squares 7" x 7" for HST

Medium Fabric

Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Dark Fabric

Cut 2 squares 7" x 7" for HST

Directions

Sew the 7" light and dark squares 1) using HST method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 6.5" square




Directions

2) Following the diagram place the medium 3.5" square on the dark Triangle, right sides together Sew ON the line.


Make 4



3) Following the diagram trim away the outer side leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Trim 4 all 4 blocks
Press triangles open
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



Square the Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"








Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"




Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the light squares



Step 2


- Layer the dark and light square
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST





-Trim squares to 6.5" x 6.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
