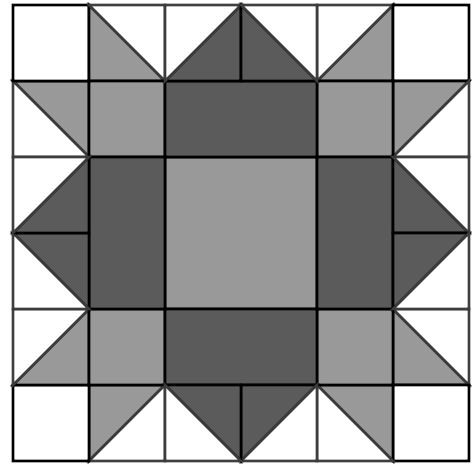
Aprons are such a fun item to make and wear.

**Unfinished Block to 24.5" x 24.5"**  
Finished in the quilt is Size 24" x 24"

## Cutting & Sewing

### Light Fabric

- Cut 8 squares 5" x 5" for HST
- Cut 4 squares 4.5" x 4.5"

### Medium Fabric

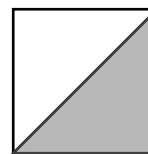
- Cut 1 square 8.5" x 8.5"
- Cut 4 squares 5" x 5" for HST
- Cut 4 squares 4.5" x 4.5"

### Dark Fabric

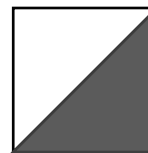
- Cut 4 rectangles 4.5" x 8.5"
- Cut 4 squares 5" x 5" for HST

### Directions

1) Sew the 5" medium and light squares  
Using HST method at the end  
Make 8 units - trim to 4.5" square



2) Sew the 5" dark and light squares  
Using HST method at the end  
Make 8 units - trim to 4.5" square

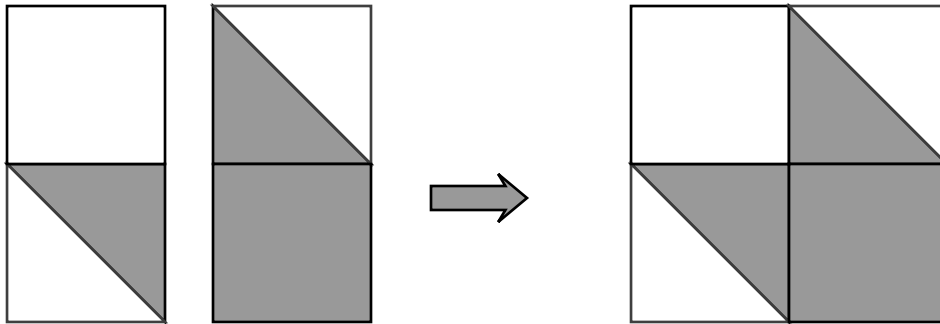

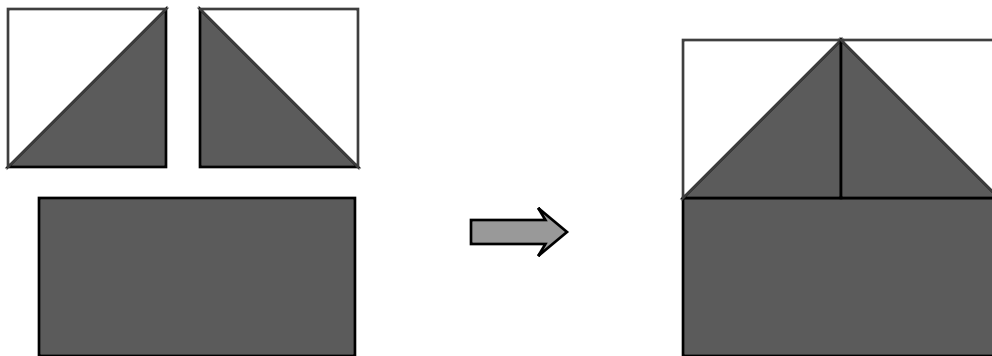

## Directions

- 3) Following the diagram Sew the light square, medium HST fabric units, and medium square  
Make 4  
Measures 8.5" x 8.5"



- 4) Following the diagram Sew the Dark fabric HST units, and the dark rectangle  
Make 4  
Measures 8.5" x 8.5"

Sew the block together  
Measures 24.5" x 24.5"

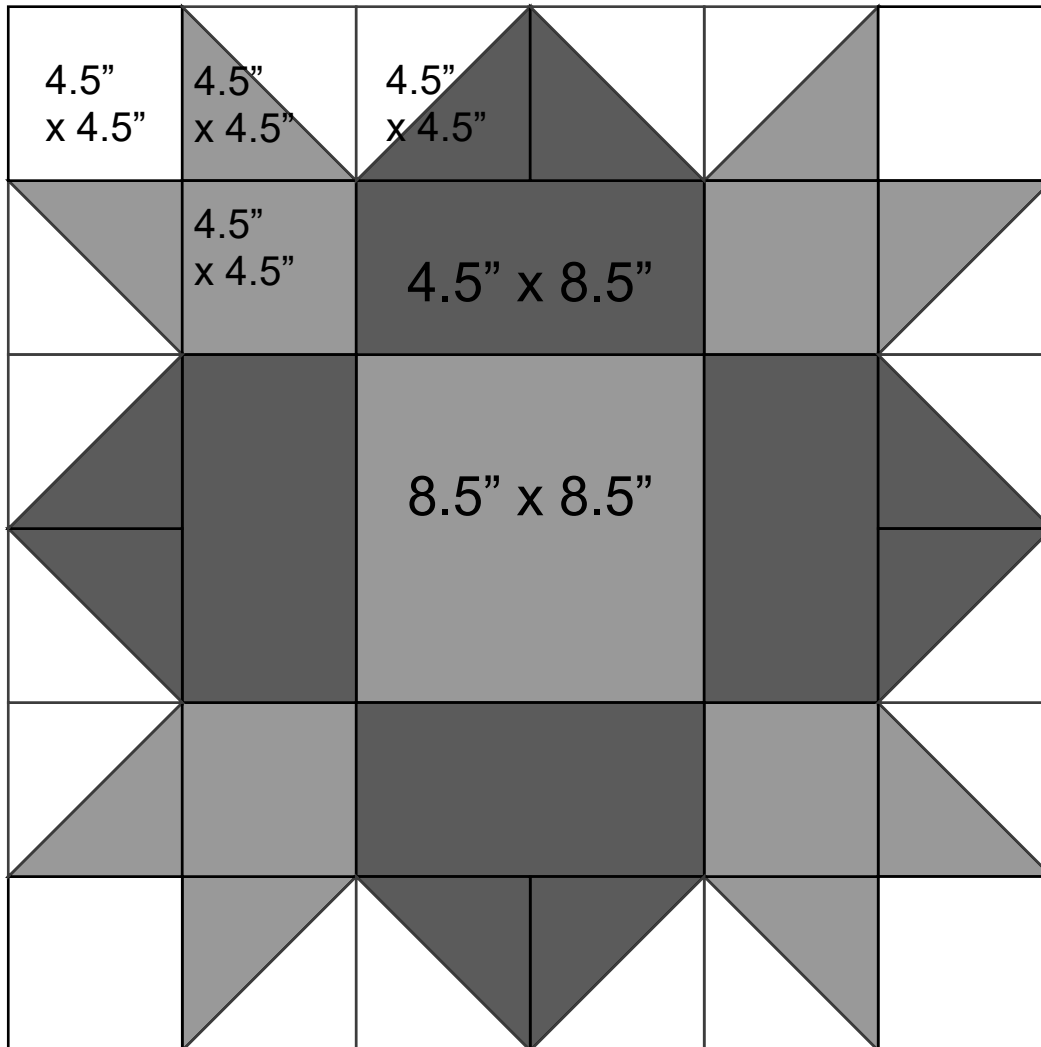

**Square the Block to 24.5" x 24.5"**

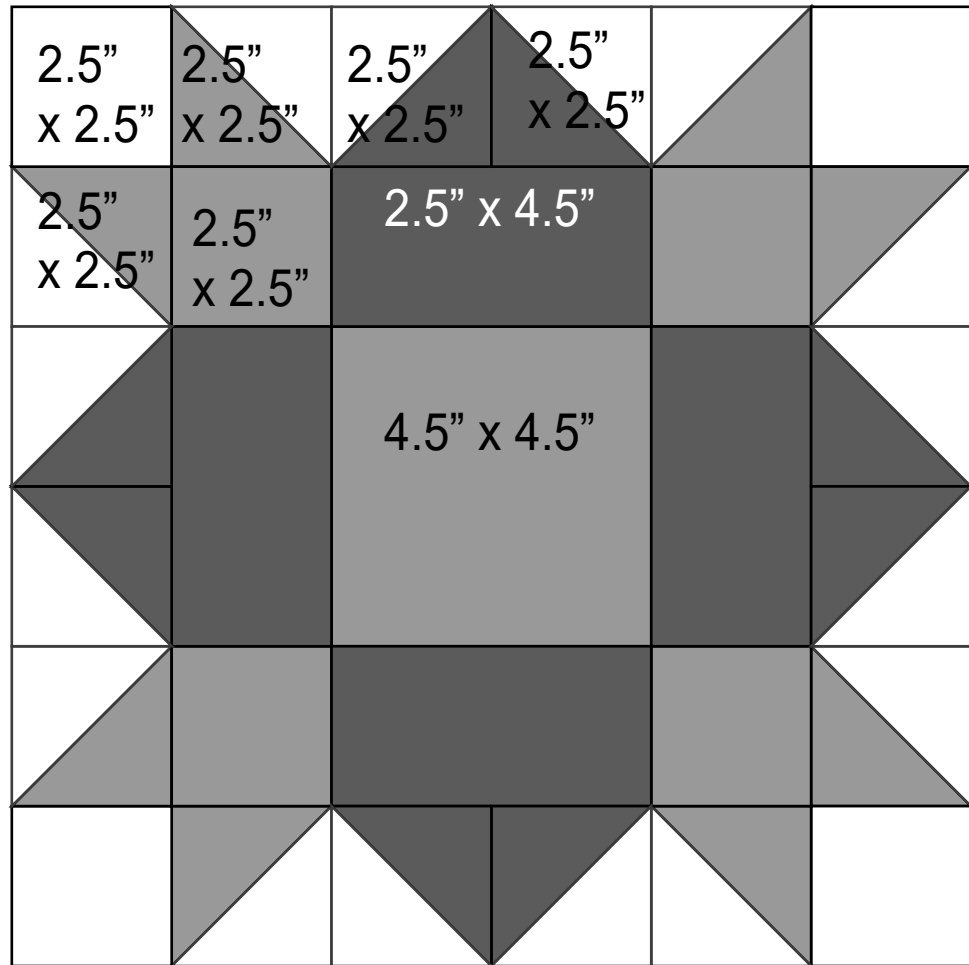

## Cutting Sizes

### NOTE-

Cut 3" x 3" squares  
For the HST  
Units.

Trim to 2.5" x 2.5"



**ALTERNATE 12" block**  
**Same HST unit & one Square**  
 IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

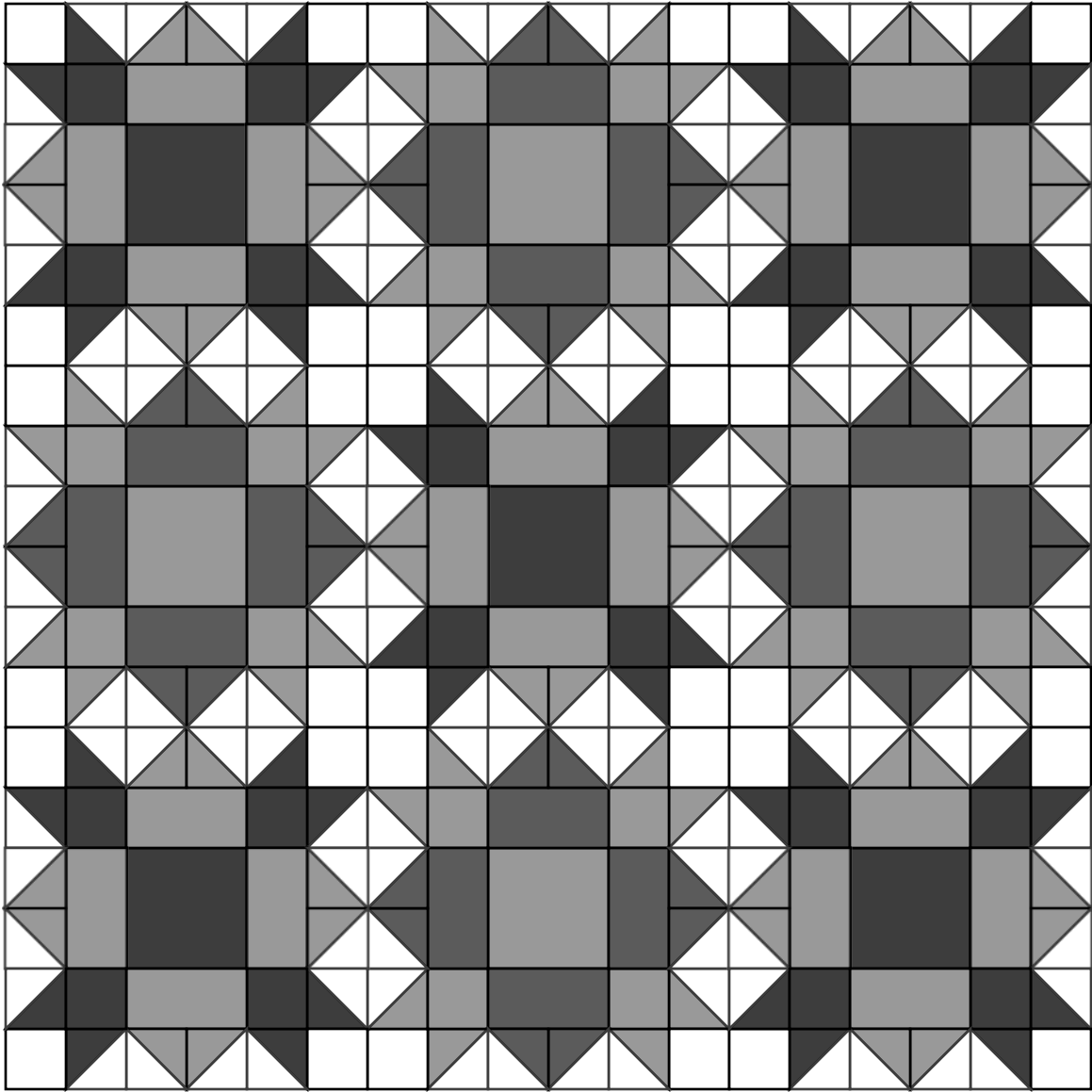

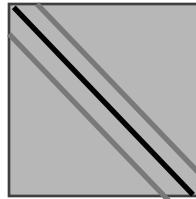
## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

**NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book  
"Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"**



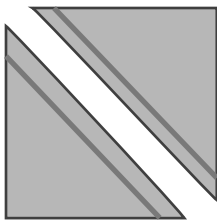
**Step 1**

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



**Step 2**

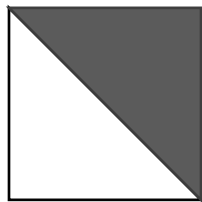
- Layer the 2 squares  
- Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



**Step 3**

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

**Step 4**



**LARGER units**

-Trim squares to 4.5" x 4.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
