School years create a lot of strong memories. I want to share a really fun, or maybe funny one of mine from Kindergarten.

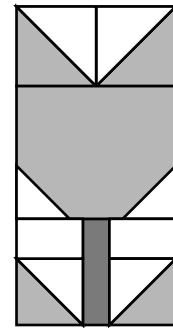
When I was in kindergarten my younger brother was 2 ½ yrs old.

Finished size 6" x 12"

### Cutting Directions

#### Background or Light fabric

- Cut 1 square 4" x 4" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 2 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 2 rectangle 3" x 2"

#### Tulip fabric

- Cut 1 square 4" x 4" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 1 square 5.5" x 6.5"

#### Leaf fabric

- Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5" for (Half square triangles HST)

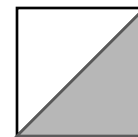
#### Stem fabric

- Cut 1 strip 1.5" x 4.5"

### Directions

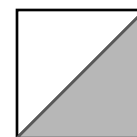
1) Using a 4" Light and a 4" Tulip fabric square make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 3.5" square  
Make 2 units



2) Using a 3.5" Light and a 3.5" leaf fabric square make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 3" square  
Make 2 units



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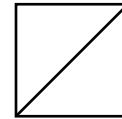

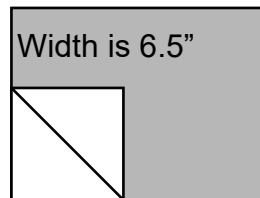
3) Draw a diagonal line on the back of all the light 2.5" squares



4) Following diagram place the 2.5" square on a left bottom corner of the 5.5" x 6.5" Tulip fabric square, right sides together. Sew ON the line.

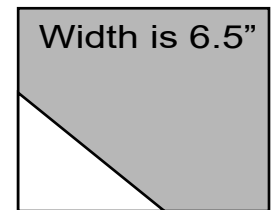
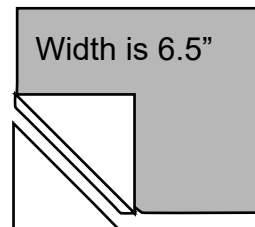
Measures 5.5" x 6.5"

Make 1



5) Following diagram trim away Leaving a 1/4" seam allowance

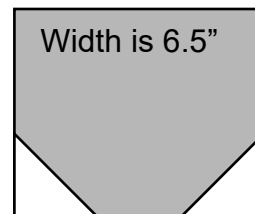
Trim Measures 5.5" x 6.5"



6) Following steps 4 & 5 above, sew the Other 2.5" light square to the right Bottom corner

Measures 5.5" x 6.5"

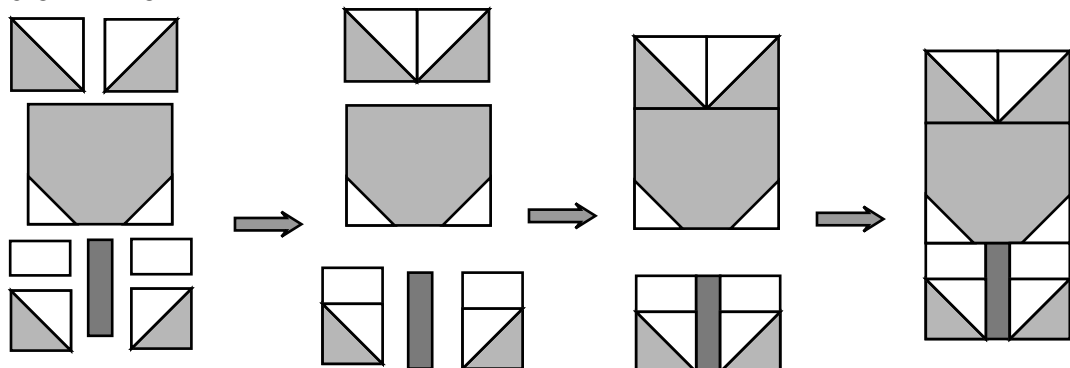
Make 1



7) Following diagrams, sew the Tulip HSTs, tulip body from step 7, stem, leaf HST, and 2 light rectangles together

Measures 6.5" x 12.5"

Make 1



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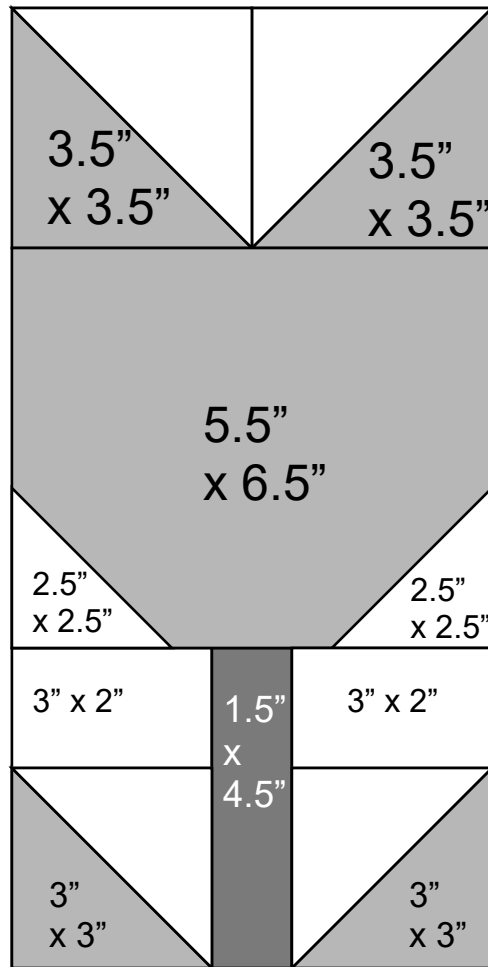

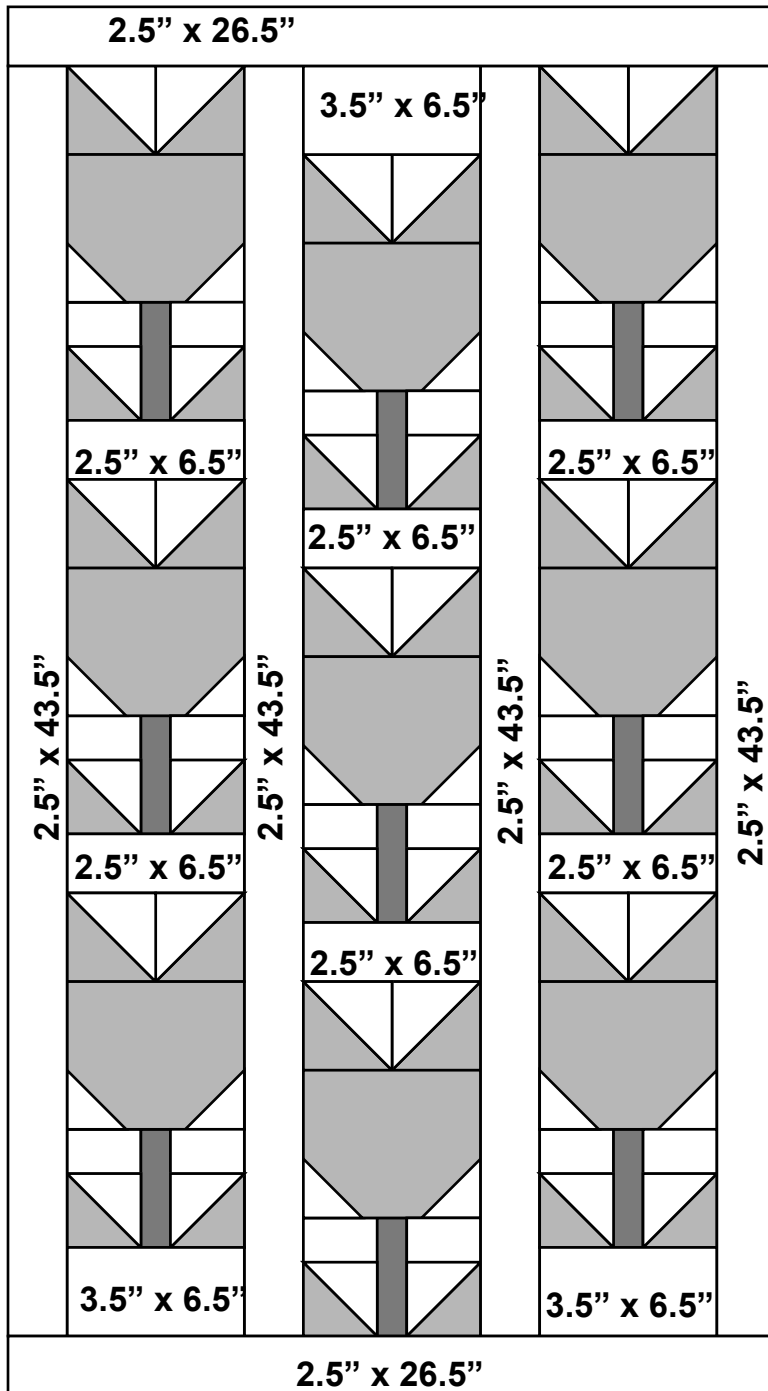

Cut Background fabric  
 - 6 strips 2.5" x 6.5"  
 - 3 strips 3.5" x 6.5"  
 - 4 strips 2.5" x 43.5"  
 - 2 strips 2.5" x 26.5"

Assemble

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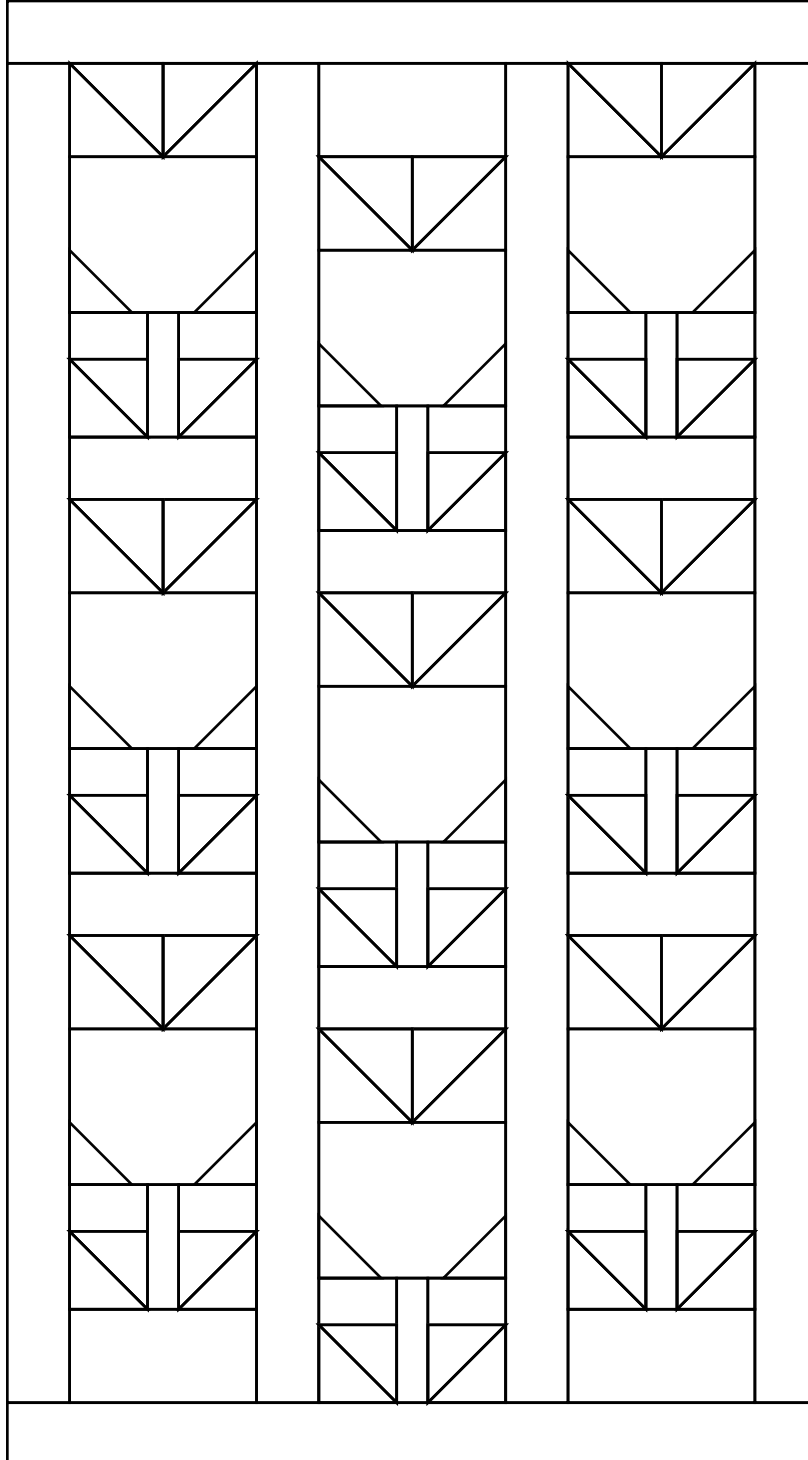

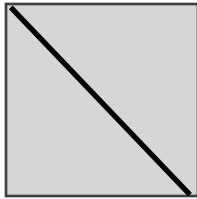
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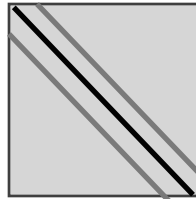
## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

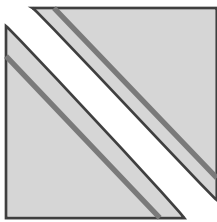
**Step 1**

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



**Step 2**

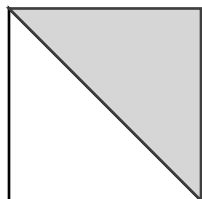
- Layer the 2 squares  
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



**Step 3**

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

**Step 4**



-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
