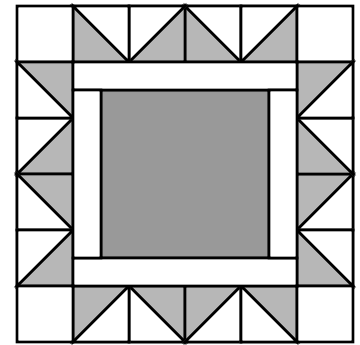

Finished size 12" x 12"

Cutting Directions

Light fabrics

- Cut 8 squares 3" x 3" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 8.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 6.5"

Medium fabrics

- Cut 8 squares 3" x 3" for (Half square triangles HST)

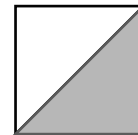
Dark fabrics

- Cut 1 square 6.5" x 6.5"

Directions

1) Using 3" Light and 3" medium fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 2.5" square
Make 16 units

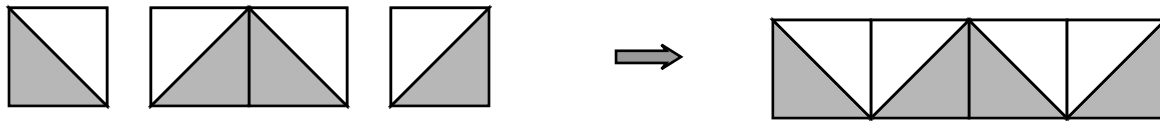

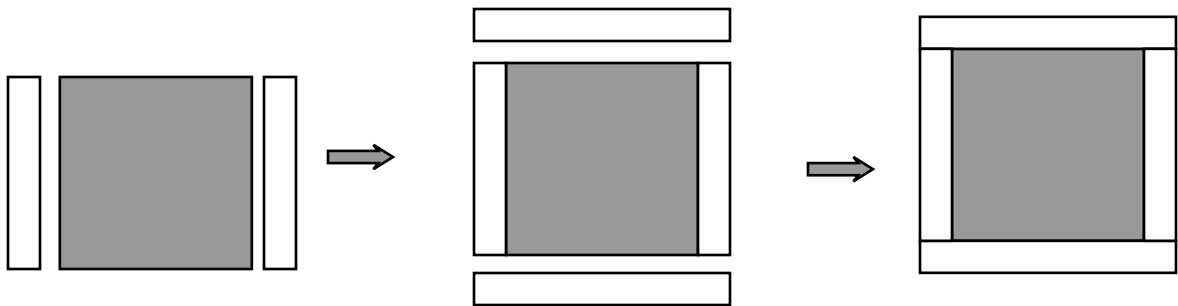

Directions

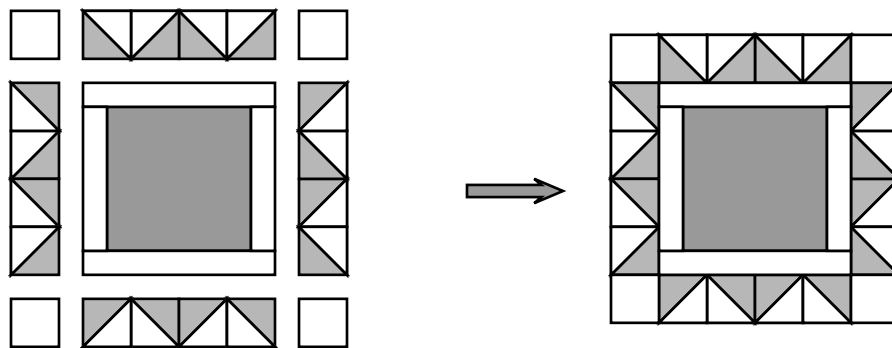
2) Following the diagram use 4 HST units from step #1 and sew them together
 Measures 2.5" x 8.5"
 Make 4 units



3) Following the diagram sew a 1.5" x 6.5" light strip to the sides the 6.5" dark square.
 Sew the 1.5" x 8.5" strips to the top and bottom of the square
 Measures 8.5" x 8.5"
 Make 1



4) Following the diagram, Assemble the block using units from the steps above and the 2.5" light squares
 Make 1
 Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

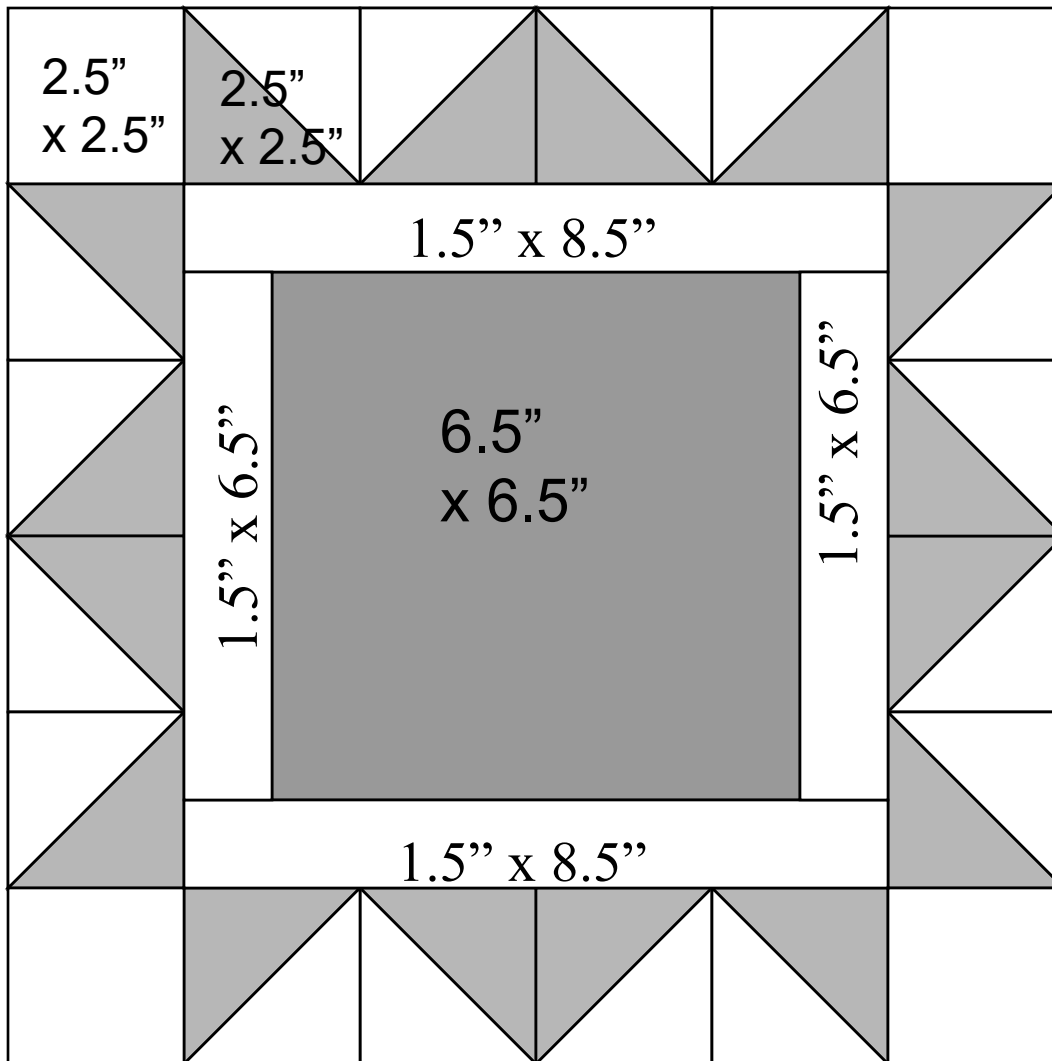

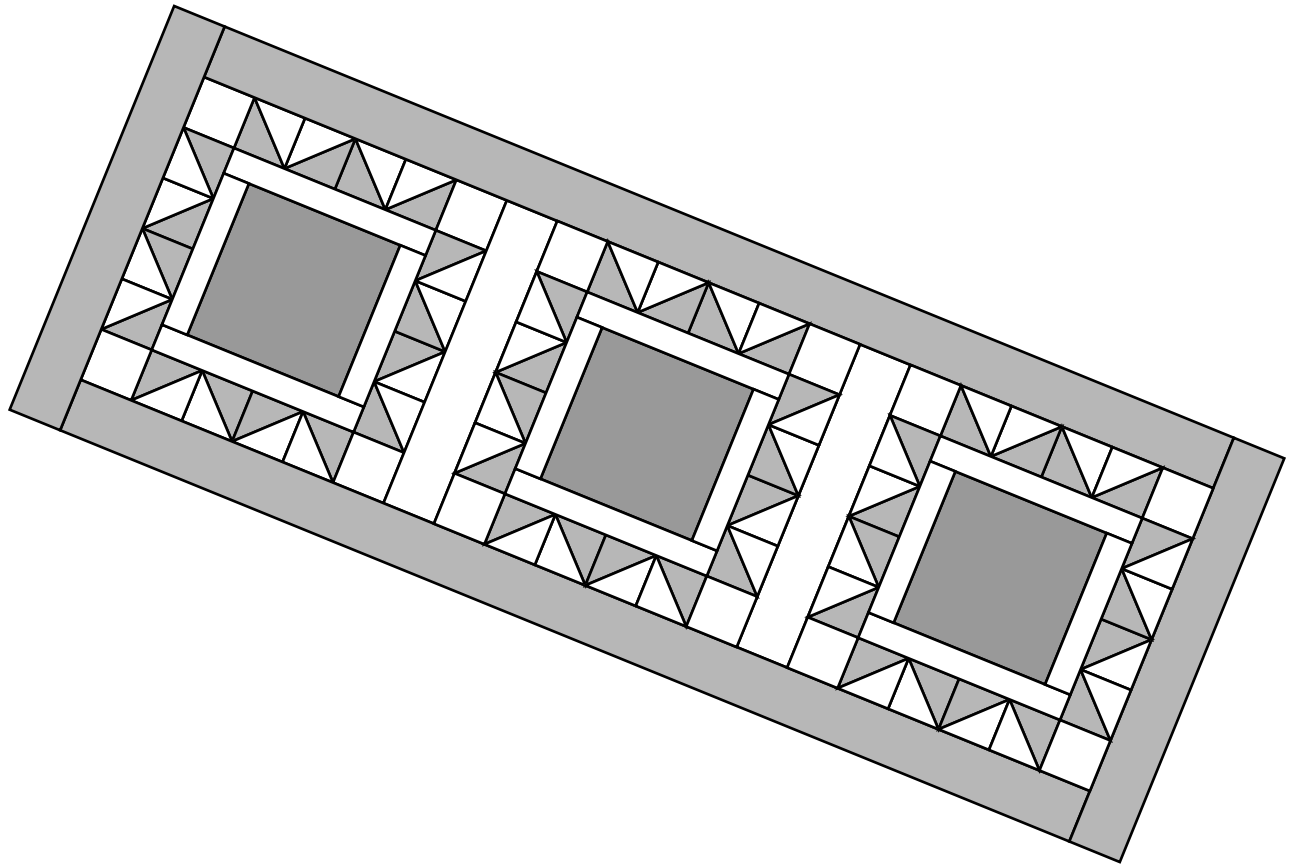

16.5” x 44.5” - 3 Blocks

Cut 2 sashing 2.5” x 12.5”

Cut 2 borders 2.5” x 16.5”

Cut 2 borders 2.5” x 40.5”

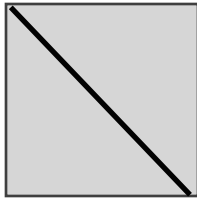

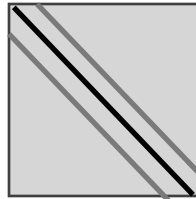
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

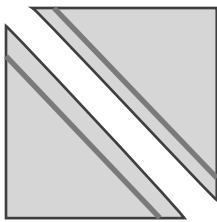
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

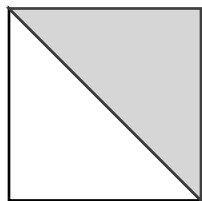
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
