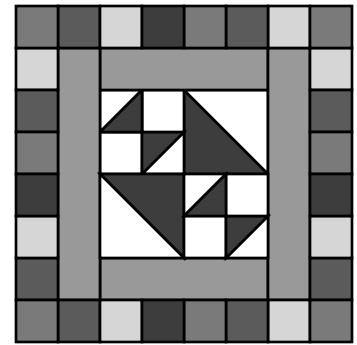

Cutting Directions

Background or Light fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 1 square 5" x 5" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 1 square 5" x 5" for (Half square triangles HST)

Inner border fabric

- Cut 2 strips 2.5" x 12.5"
- Cut 2 strips 2.5" x 8.5"

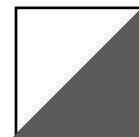
Outer border fabrics

- Cut a variety of 28 fabric squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Directions

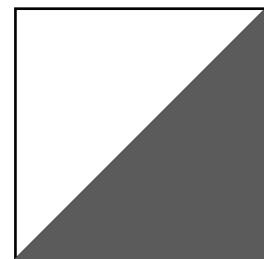
1) Using a 3" Light and a 3" dark fabric square make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 2.5" square
Make 4 units



2) Using a 5" Light and a 5" dark fabric square make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 4.5" square
Make 2 units



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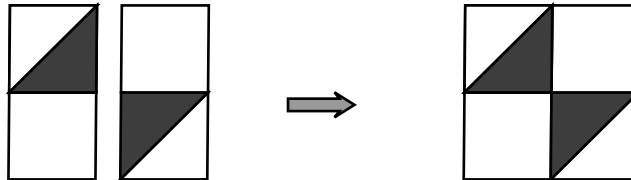
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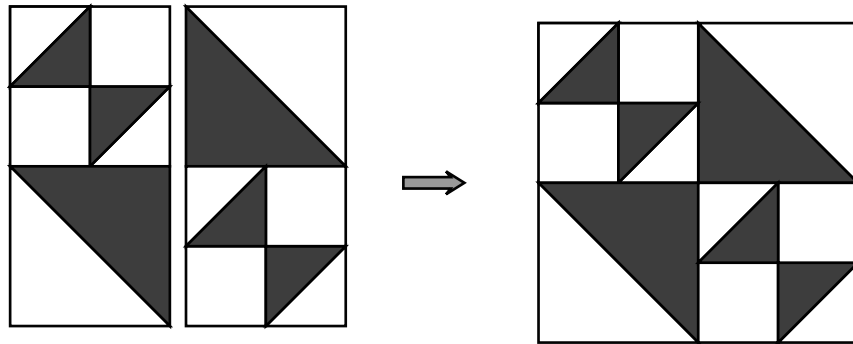

Directions

- 3) Following diagrams, sew the 2.5" HSTs and light 2.5" squares together
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 2



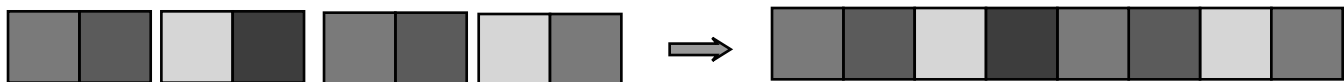
- 4) Following diagrams, sew the 4.5" HSTs and the 2 units from step #3 together
Measures 8.5" x 8.5"
Make 1



- 5) Following diagrams, sew 6 of the outer border 2.5" squares together
Measures 2.5" x 12.5"
Make 2



- 6) Following diagrams, sew 8 of the outer border 2.5" squares together
Measures 2.5" x 16.5"
Make 2

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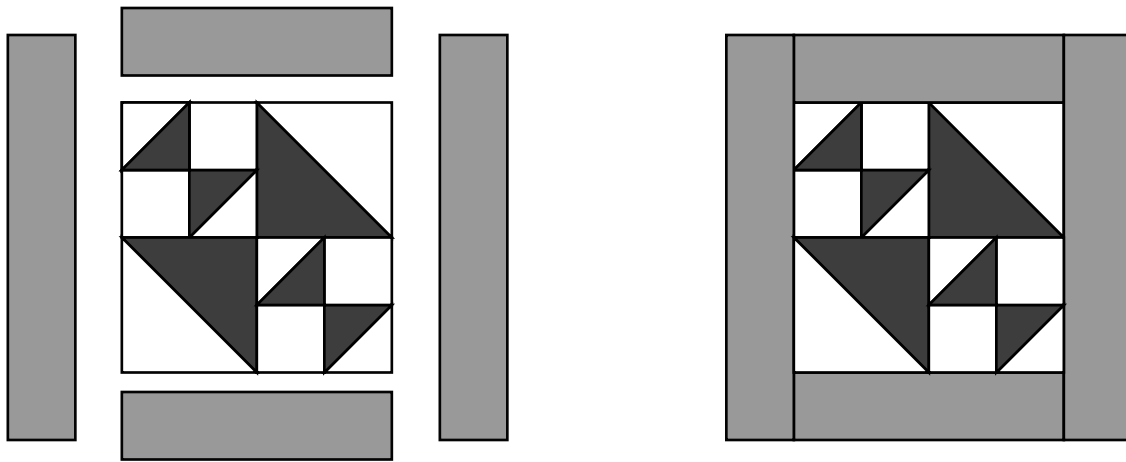
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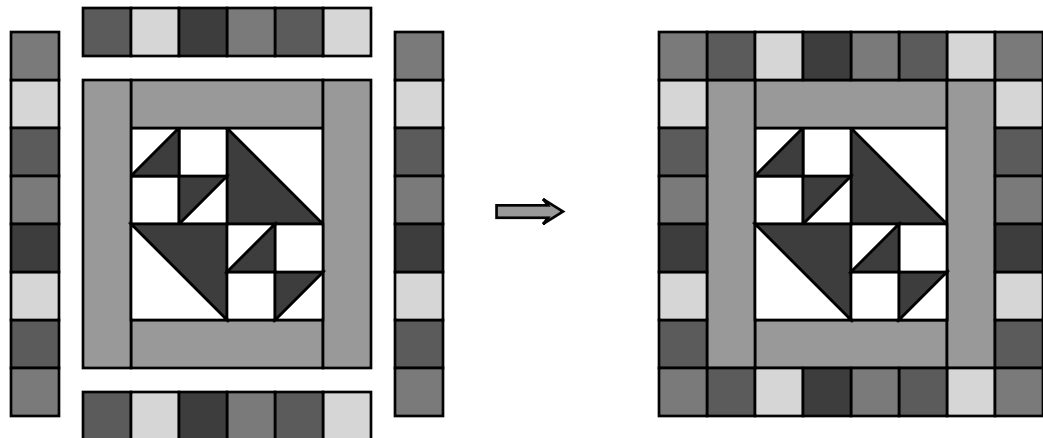

Directions

- 7) Following the diagram, sew the inner top and bottom border to the unit from step #4. Then sew the side borders on.
Measures 12.5" x 12.5"
Make 1



- 8) Following the diagram, sew the top and bottom border from step #5 to the block. Then sew on the side borders from step #6.
Measures 16.5" x 16.5"
Make 1



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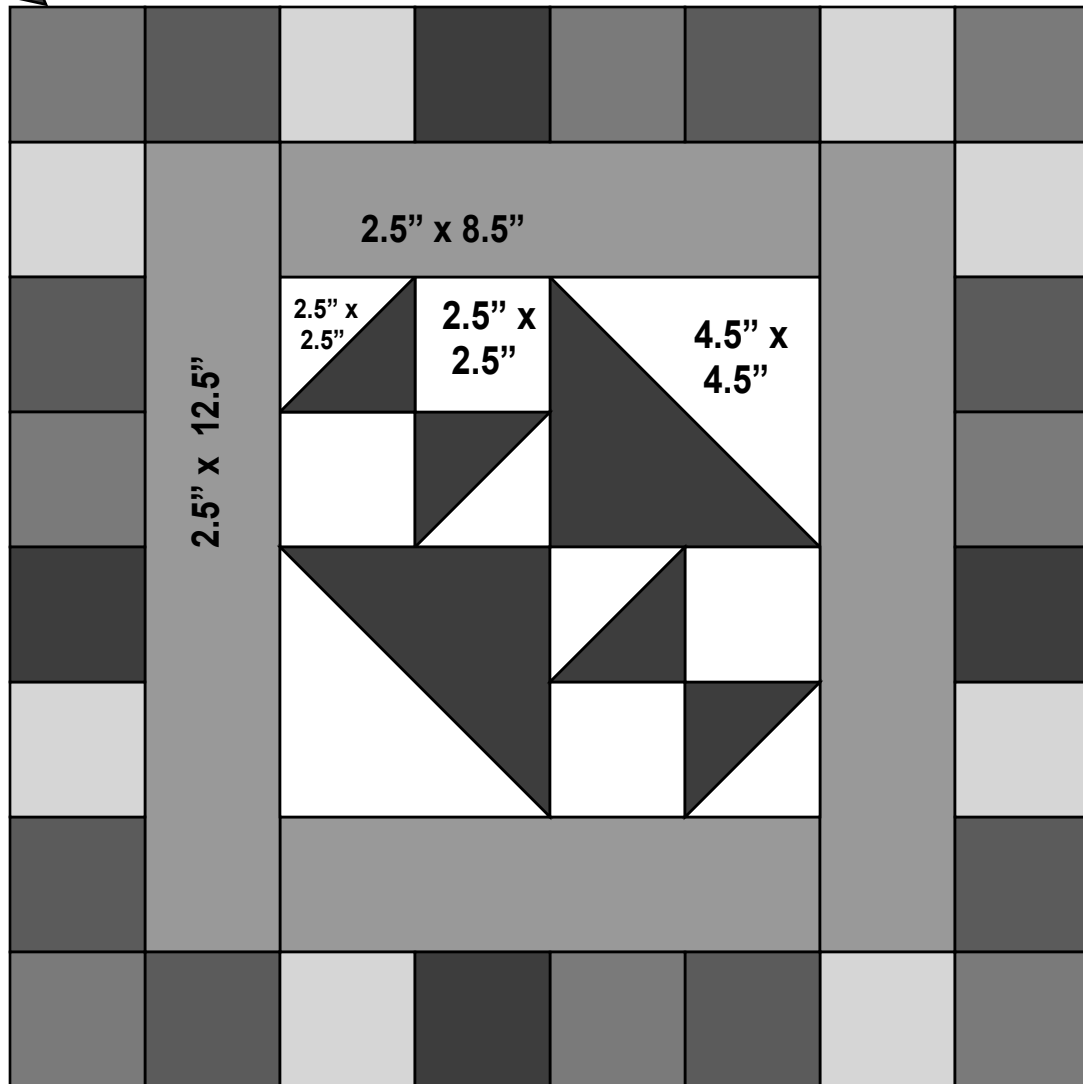

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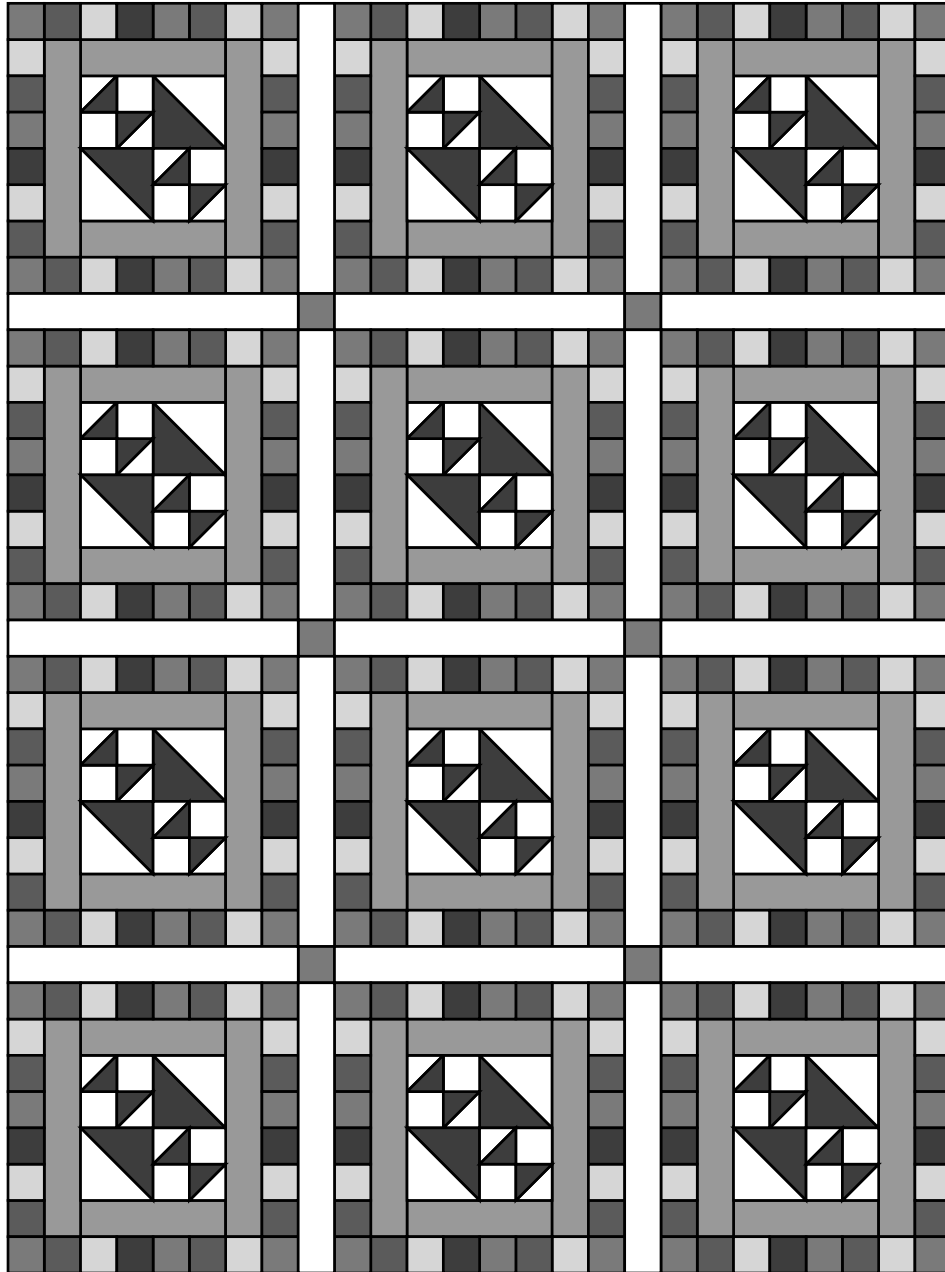

Cut

17 sashing strips 2.5" x 16.5"

6 squares 2.5" x 2.5

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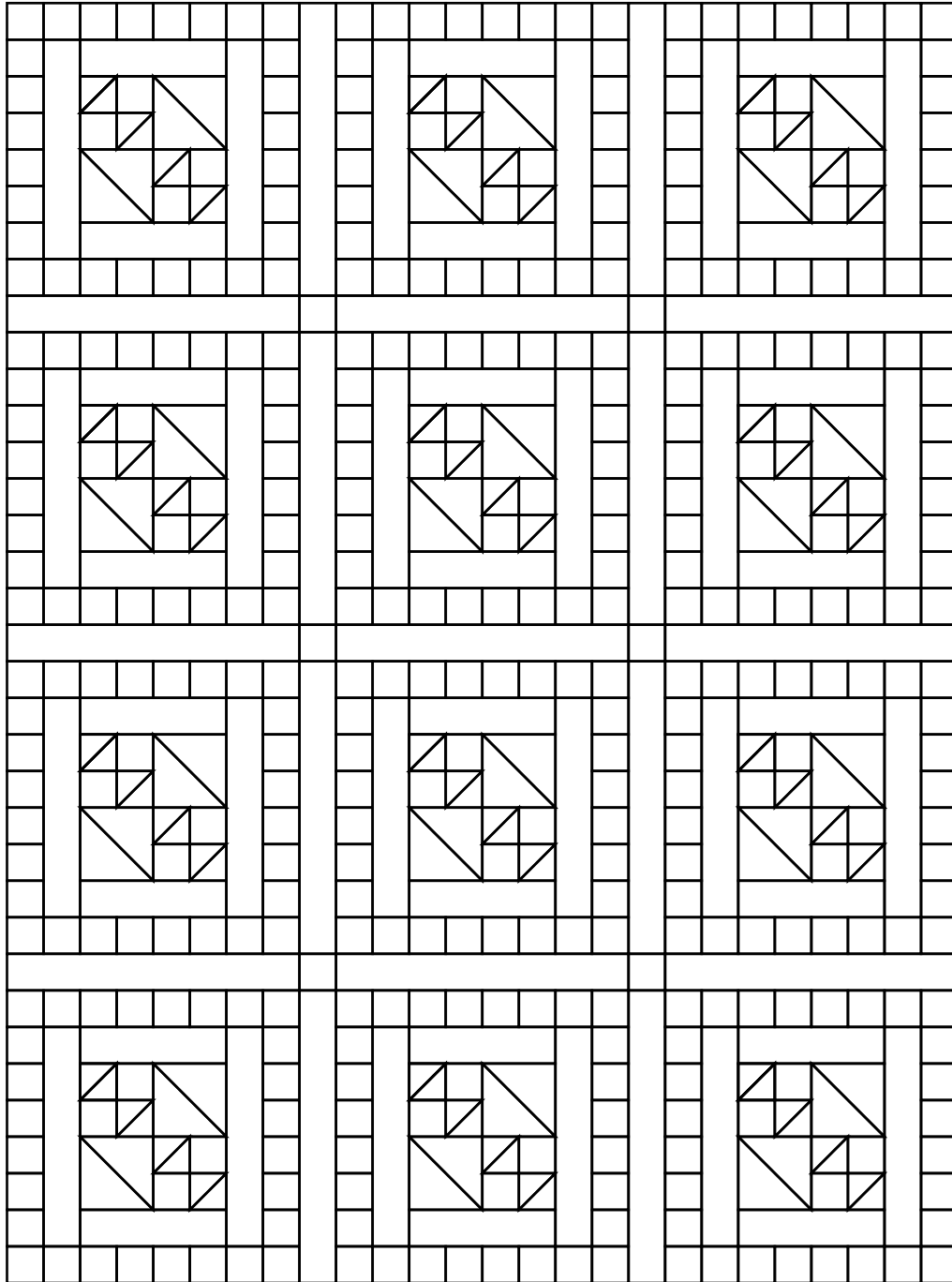

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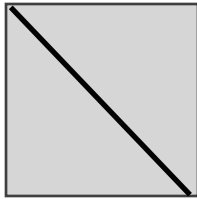
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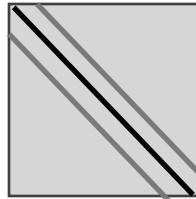
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

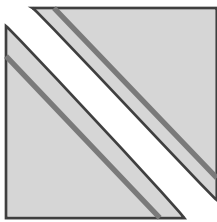
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

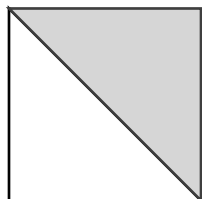
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
