trim to 6.5" square

Cutting Directions

Light fabric

- Cut 2 squares 7" x 7" for HST (Half square Triangles)
- Cut 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Medium fabric 1

- Cut 2 squares 7" x 7" for HST (Half square Triangles)

Medium fabric 2


- Cut 4 rectangles 4.5" x 6.5"

Dark fabric

- Cut 1 square 4.5" x 4.5"
- Cut 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

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Sew a light 7" squares and a medium 1 fabric 7"

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Directions

2) Draw a diagonal line on the back of the dark and light 2.5" squares






3) Following the diagram, Place a 2.5" light square on the left top corner of the medium 2 4.5" x 6.5" rectangle. Sew ON the line.

Place a dark 2.5" square on the right top corner. Sew ON the line.






4) Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance on both corners Press triangles open to create unit

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
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5) Following the diagram, Place a 2.5" light square on the left bottom corner of the medium 4.5" x 6.5" rectangle from the prior step. Sew ON the line.

Place a dark 2.5" square on the right Bottom corner. Sew ON the line.






4) Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance on both corners Press triangles open to create unit Make 4

4) Following the diagram sew all the units together Make 1
Measures 16.5" x 16.5"



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


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
