
Block 2/25 Sticky buns

Grandma's Kitchen Challenge

Many a childhood memory involves food, which may be the 'love language' of grandmas everywhere. Neither of mine were necessarily the best cooks, but I still have great food memories.

I'm not sure if sticky buns are so massively popular all around the world, but they were the best thing ever to my family in Pennsylvania. A sticky bun is a sweet yeast roll. The dough is rolled flat, you sprinkle it with cinnamon and sugar. Then roll into a spiral. It is topped with a sticky cinnamon sugar glaze and chopped pecans nuts, or even half pecans pieces.



SQUARE Block to 12.5" x 12.5" Finished in the guilt is Size 12"

We serve them slightly warm. One grandma warmed them in her 'dutch oven' and the other did in the regular oven. My Granny bought them at the Farmer's Market where she worked. When she walked in with the beautiful white bakery boxes you never knew what sweet treat was inside!

For years I made my own sticky buns from scratch as there was no place to duplicate what my grandma had.

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 4 squares 2" x 2"
- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 4 rectangles 2" x 5.5"

Medium Fabric

- Cut 2 rectangles 2" x 9.5"
- Cut 2 rectangles 2" x 2.5"


Dark Fabric

- Cut 2 rectangles 2.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 2 rectangles 2.5" x 5.5"

Directions

1) Sew the 2.5" x 5.5" dark rectangles To either side of the 2.5" light square for the middle unit of the block

Make 1 units - Measures to 2.5" x 12.5"





Directions

2) Following the diagram Sew the 3 vertical strip units Then sew them together Make 2 Measures 5.5" x 12.5"



3) Sew a 3 strip unit to each side of the center strip. Be sure to rotate so the long medium fabric strip in on the inside. Block is 12.5" x 12.5"







2" x	2.5" x 3.5"	2" x 2"
5.5"	0.5"	2" x 9.5"
2" x 2.5"	2.5" x 6.5"	
2" x 5.5"		
5.5"	2.5" x 3.5"	2" x 2"






Square the Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"



Sashing Cutting Directions -48 light strips 2.5" x 5.5" -25 light strips 2.5" x 12.5"


Corner blocks -54 dark squares 2.5" x 2.5"

58" x 72" quilt using just this block with sashings & corners blocks
