
A Flower Bouquet Block 3/20 - Planting Guide

Block is 12.5" x 12.5" Finished size 12" x 12"

Ruler Cutting

Light fabrics

- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4"
- Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 16 squares 2" x 2"

Medium fabrics

- Cut 1 square 6.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 16 squares 2" x 2"

TIP: For a scrappy

Block cut from multiple Light and dark fabric For the 2" x 2" squares

Light fabrics

- Cut 4 triangles 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 16 squares 2" x 2"

Medium fabrics

- Cut 1 square 6.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 4 triangles 3.5" x 3.5"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 16 squares 2" x 2"


Directions

1) Using the 4" light and 4" medium fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF or use one of the other methods from my Triangle book trim to 3.5" square Make 4 units




2) Following the diagram Sew 4 light 2" x 2" squares and 4 dark 2" x 2" squares together to make a 8-patch unit Make 4
Measures 3.5" x 6.5"

TIP: if using directional fabric carefully place blocks in the correct direction.



3) Following the diagram Place the Light 3.5" square on the medium 6.5" square, right sides together


Sew ON the line. Make 1



4) Following the diagram place another Light square on the medium square, right sides together


Sew ON the line.

Make 1



5) Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Trim off both ends Press triangles open to make a square

Measure 6.5" x 6.5"







Directions

6) Following the diagram Light 3.5" square on the medium 6.5" square, right sides together Sew ON the line.

Make 1




7) Following the diagram place another Light square on the medium square, right sides together

Sew ON the line.


Make 1



8) Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Trim off both ends Press triangles open to make a square Measure 6.5" x 6.5"



9) Following the diagram piece the block Measure 12.5" x 12.5"






