
A Flower Bouquet Block 4/20 - Gazebos

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"

Finished size 12" x 12" What makes a great garden Gazebo? I love them to be white, and not too big. It will be rimmed with flowers, maybe a lot of roses. And there needs to be a little stone pathway up to it. Add wicker furniture, a pitcher of ice tea and it will be a perfect oasis in the back yard.

Ruler Cutting

Light fabrics

- Cut 2 squares 7" x 7"
- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4"

Medium fabrics

- Cut 1 square 7" x 7"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 1 squares 7" x 7"
- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4"

- **Light fabrics**
- Cut 3 triangles 6.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 4 triangles 3.5" x 3.5"

Medium fabrics

- Cut 2 triangles 6.5" x 6.5"

Dark Fabric


- Cut 1 triangle 6.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 4 triangles 3.5" x 3.5"

Directions

1) Using the 4" light and 4" dark fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF or use one of the other methods from my Triangle book

trim to 3.5" square

Make 4 units

2) Using the 7" light and 7" medium fabric squares make HSTs trim to 6.5" square Make 2 units




3) Using the 7" light and 7" dark fabric squares make HSTs trim to 6.5" square Make 2 units -




NOTE - you will only use one. I suggest using the Other for the label of your guilt

4) Following the diagram Sew the 4 small hst units together Make 1

Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



Following the diagram, Assemble the block 5) Make 1 Measures 12.5" x 12.5"





IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"




