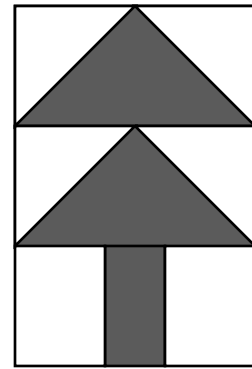

Cutting Directions

Light fabric

- Cut 16 squares 4.5" x 4.5"
- Cut 8 rectangles 3.5" x 4.5"

Tree Fabric - you can make each One different

- Cut 8 rectangle 4.5" x 8.5"

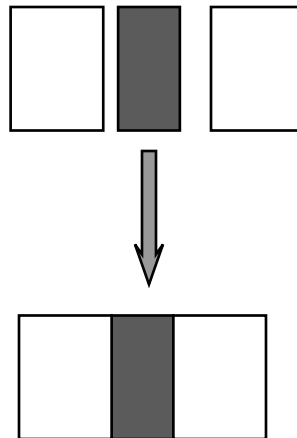
Tree trunk Fabric

- Cut 4 strip 2.5" x 4.5"

Directions

Using the 2 light 3.5" x 4.5" rectangles and the tree Trunk rectangle, make the tree trunk unit.

Measures 4.5" x 8.5"
Make 4 units

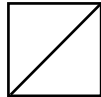

Flying Geese Units

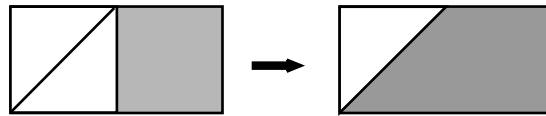
Step 1 Directions

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on each 4.5" light square
- Make 16



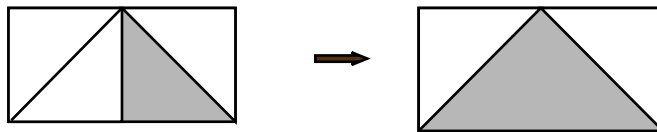
Step 2 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a light square on the tree fabric rectangle
 - 2) Sew on the line.
 - 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
 - 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 8 - Measures 4.5" x 8.5"



Step 3 Directions

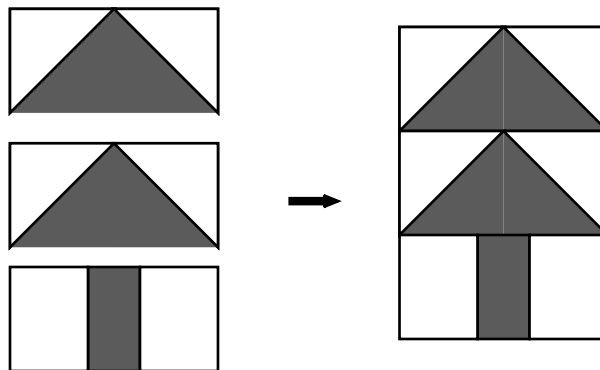
- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese
- 2) Make 8
- 3) Measures 4.5" x 8.5"



Assemble the Tree Block

Follow the diagram using 2 Tree units from above and 1 Tree trunk unit from page #1.

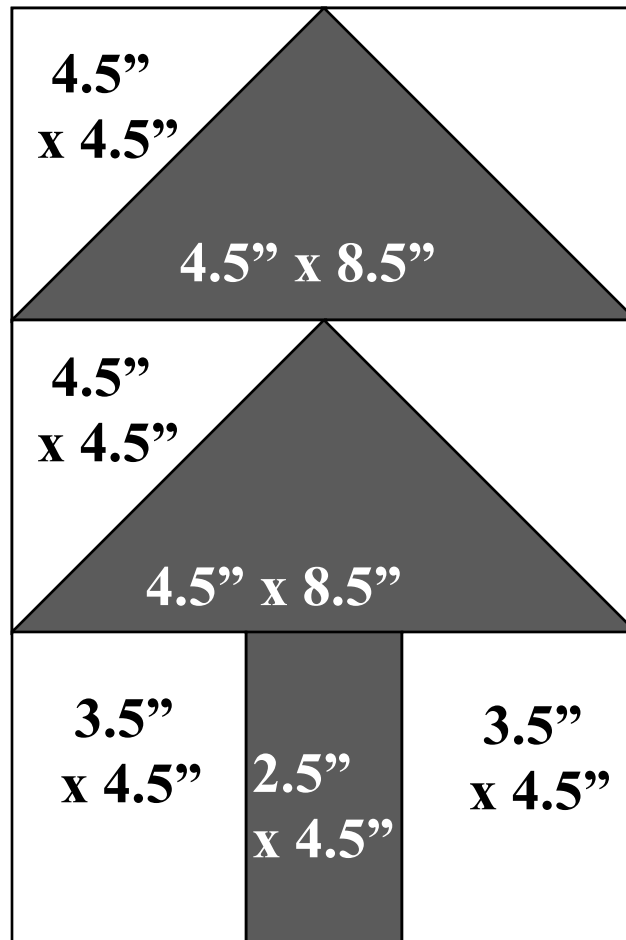
Measures 8.5" x 12.5"
Make 4 units

IN the Quilt it is finished size 8" x 12"

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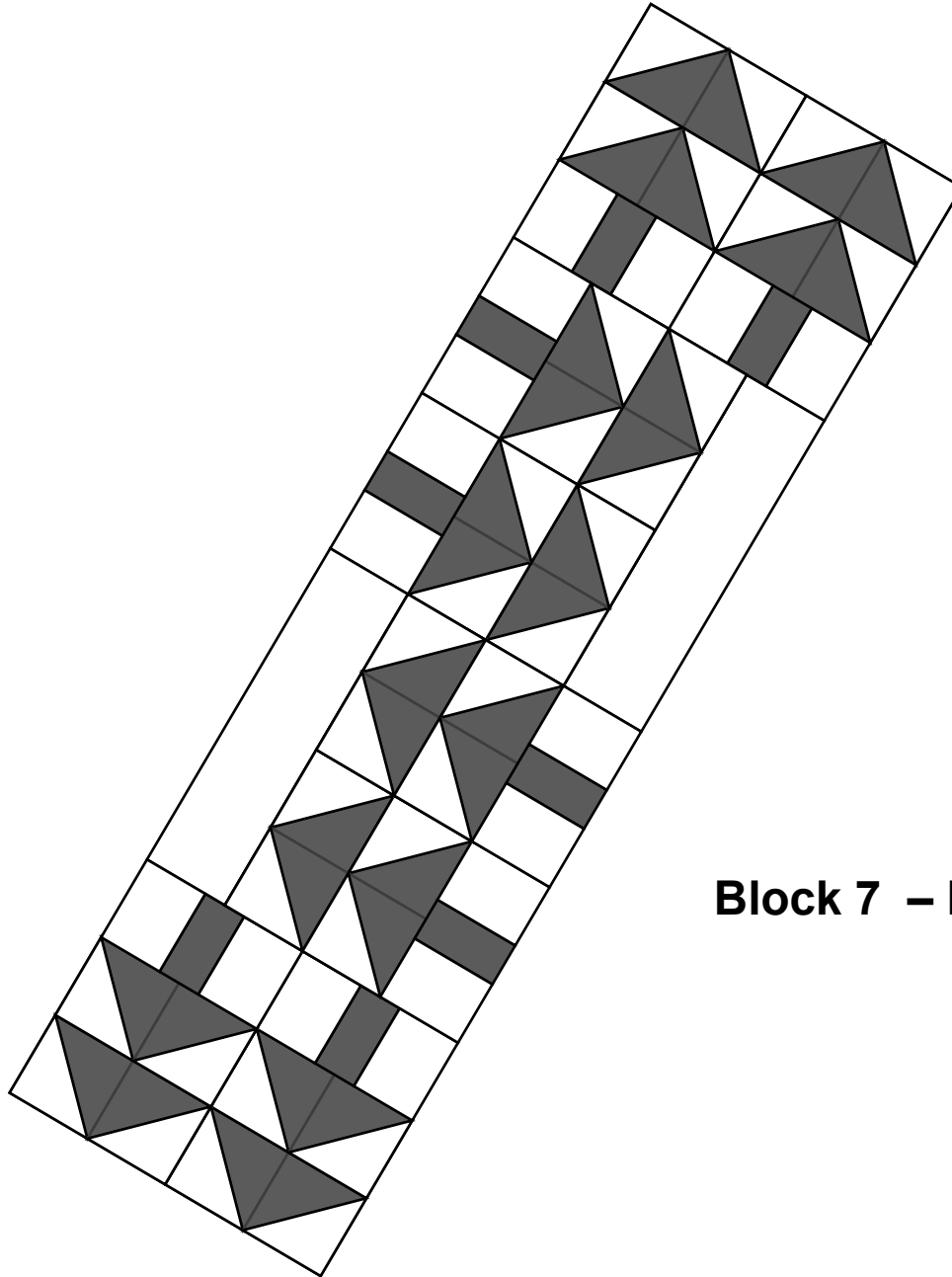

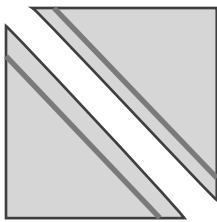
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

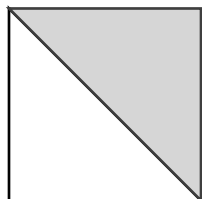
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 3.5" x 3.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
