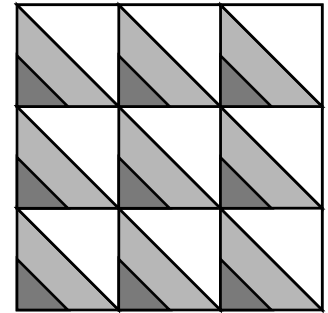

Cutting Directions

Background or Light fabric

– Cut 5 squares 5" x 5" for
Half Square triangles (HST)

Medium fabric

– Cut 5 squares 5" x 5" for
Half Square triangles (HST)

Dark Fabric

– Cut 9 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

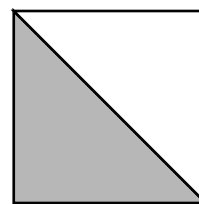
Directions

1) Using the 5" Medium and 5" light squares
make HSTs using method on the last page

Trim to 4.5" square

Make 9 units

There will be one left over
for your 'Parts Center'

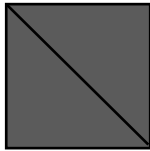

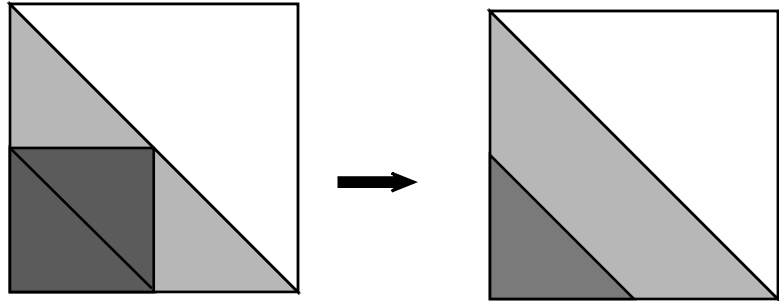
Directions

2) Using the 2.5" dark square do a sew and flip corner on the HST from Step #1



Step A Directions

Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" square
Make 9

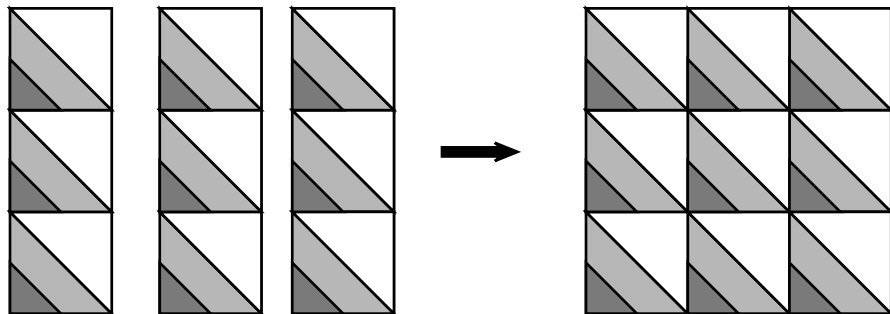


Step B Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a square on the HST
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 5) Make 4 Measures 4.5" x 4.5"

3) Following the diagram sew all 9 blocks together

Measures 12.5" x 12.5"
Make 1

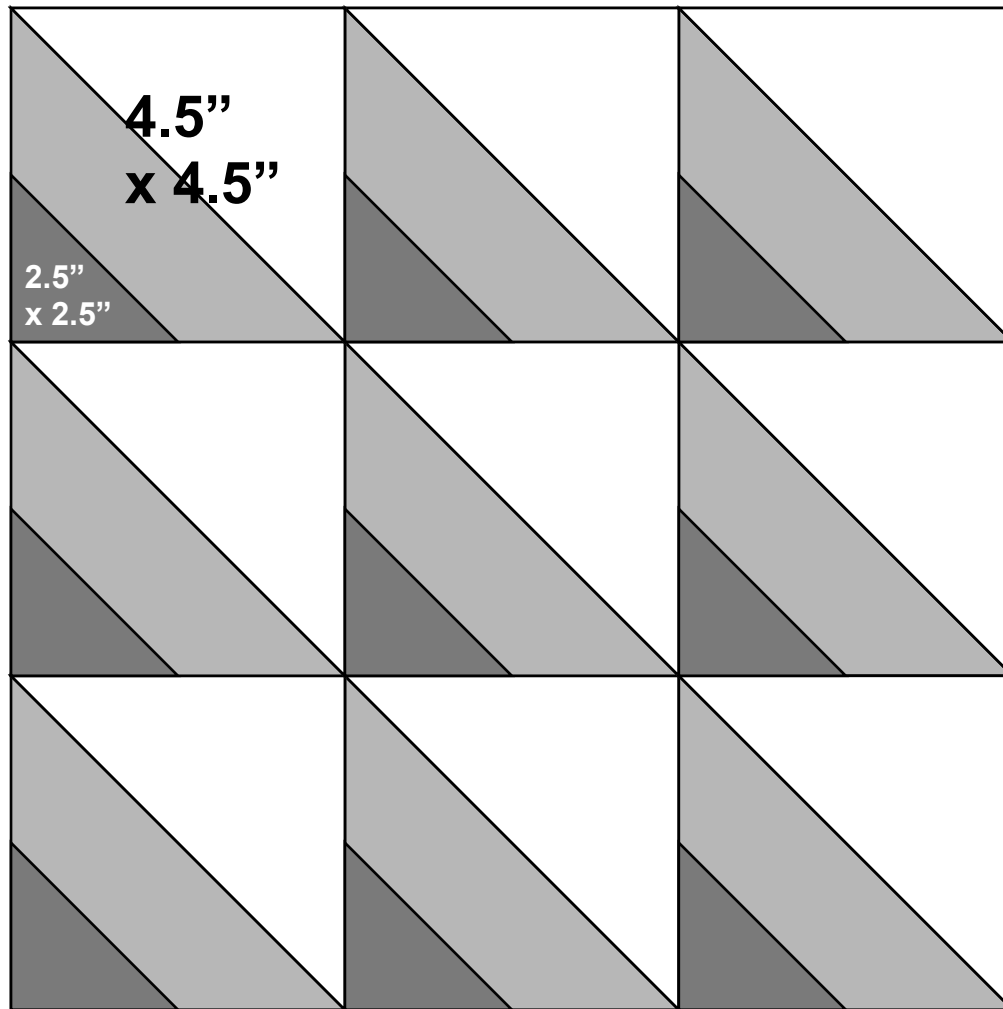

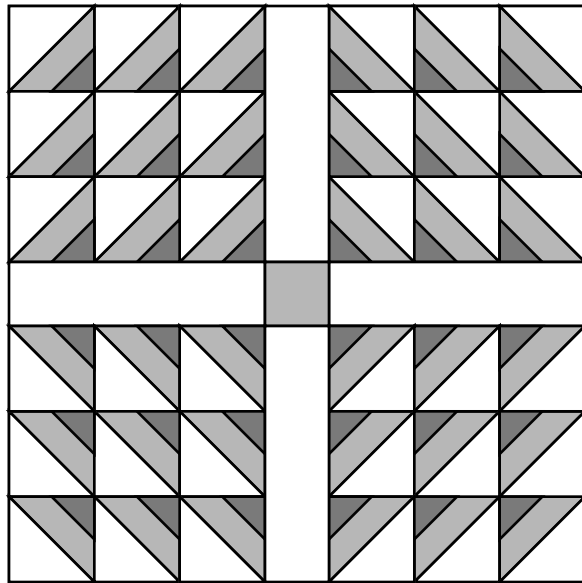

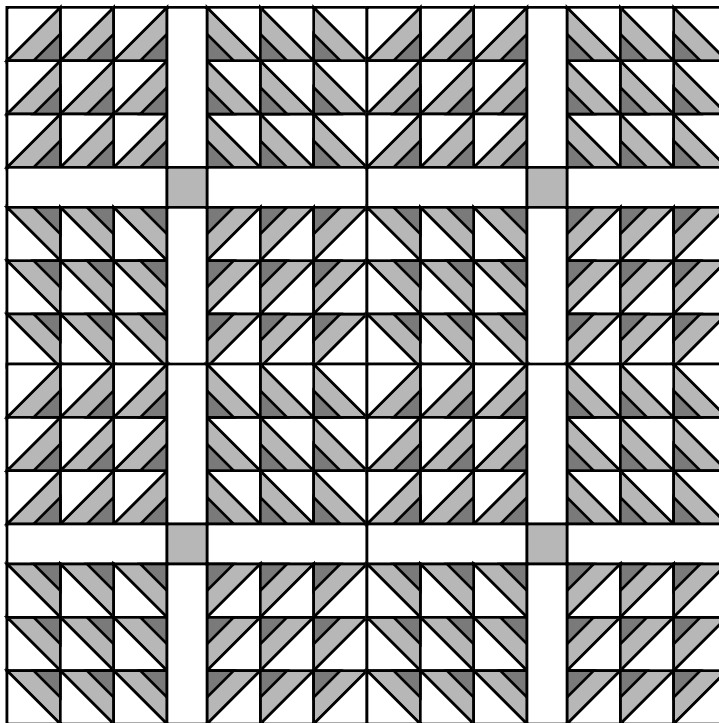
****Size ****

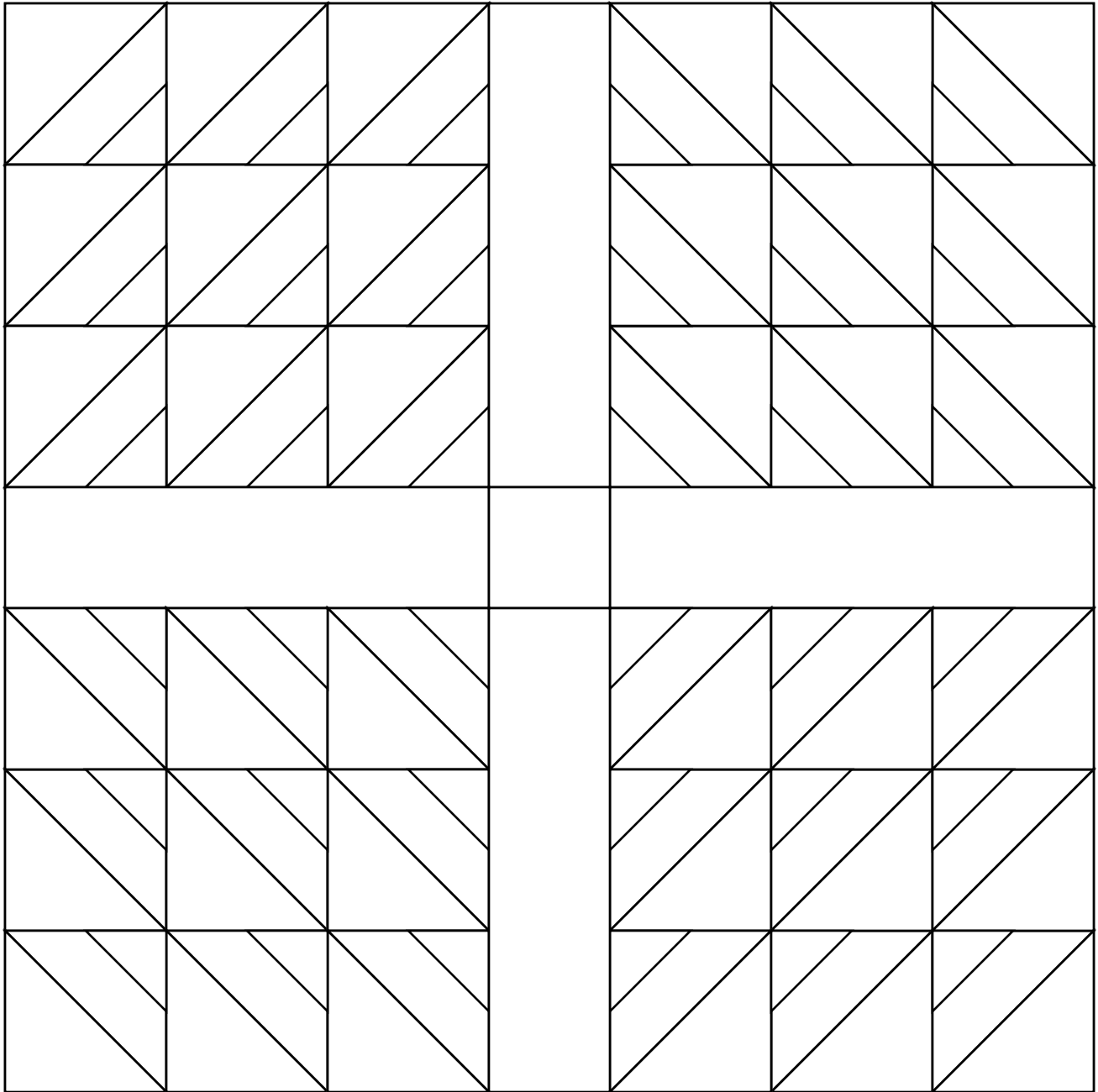

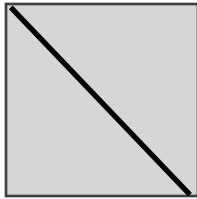

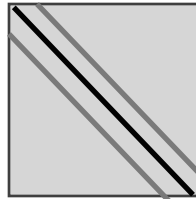
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

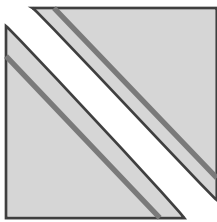
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

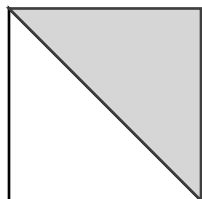
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
