



#### **Background fabric**


- 2 squares 11" x 11" For HST

#### onyx jasmine (black)

- 2 squares 11" x 11 " For HST

#### tuberose twigs (pink)

- 2 strips 2.5" x 52.5"
- 2 strips 2.5" x 36.5"
- 2 strips 2" x 30.5"
- 2 strips 2" x 27.5"
- 12 strips 2.5" x 10.5"
- 2 strips 4.5" x 10.5"
- 4 strips 3.5" x 10.5"
- 6 strips 4.5" x 6.5"

#### **Directions**

1) Using the 11" background and 11" Onyx fabric squares make HSTs using method on my HST page at the end of these directions




Trim to 10.5" square Make 4 units

2) Following the diagram sew the center using all the 9.5" x 9.5" blocks Sew a 2" x 27.5" inner border to the top and bottom Sew a 2" x 30.5" inner border to the sides

Measures 30.5" x 30.5"


Make 1 unit



3) Following the diagram sew the 3.5" x 30.5" block inner border to the sides Sew a 3.5" x 36.5" block inner border to the top and bottom

Measures 36.5" x 36.5"

Make 1 unit

4) Following the diagram sew 4 of the  $6.5^{\circ}$  x  $6.5^{\circ}$  blocks and the 3 of the  $4.5^{\circ}$  x  $6.5^{\circ}$  tuberose twigs fabric units together

Measures 6.5" x 36.5"


Make 2 units



5) Following the diagram sew units from above to the top and bottom of the center Sew the  $2.5" \times 36.5"$  tuberose twigs strips to the top and bottom Sew the  $2.5" \times 52.5"$  tuberose twigs strips to the sides

Measures 40.5" x 52.5"

Make 1 units



6) Following the diagram sew top and bottom rows using the HST units, 2 of the 2.5" x 10.5" Tuberose Twigs strips, 2 of the 3.5" x 10.5" Tuberose Twigs strips, and 3 of the 10.5" x 10.5" Blocks

Measures 10.5" x 60.5"

Make 2 units





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

7) Following the diagram sew the side rows using the 4 of the 2.5" x 10.5" Tuberose Twigs strips, 1 of the 4.5" x 10.5" Tuberose Twigs strips, and 4 of the 10.5" x 10.5" Blocks

Measures 10.5" x 52.5" Make 2 units



8) Following the diagram sew the units from step #7 to the sides Sew the HST units from step #6 to the top and bottom, note the direction of HST Measures 60.5" x 72.5" Make 1 unit

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
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
#### **Half Square Triangles Tutorial**


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2


- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
